## Call for Panels and Papers

Organised by Project Southeast Asia, the Southeast Asian Studies Symposium is the world's largest annual Southeast Asian Studies conference.



The 5<sup>th</sup> Symposium will be held in the Mathematical Institute, University of Oxford, from Thursday 14 April to Saturday 16 April 2016. We invite proposals for panels, roundtables, workshops, and papers. The 2016 Symposium will focus on the theme of “Human and Environmental Welfare in Southeast Asia”, but proposals on any topics relating to Southeast Asia are welcome.

The deadline for proposal submission is **1 October 2015**.

In 2016, we introduce a new type of academic structure: the **Forum**. The forum is a sequence of sessions with a clearly defined theme and goal. It aims to enable participants to discuss ideas, develop relationships, and formulate solutions through participating in the series of sessions.

The Symposium will also offer alternative opportunities outside formal panels, include opportunities for group meetings/discussions/project debates; documentary and movie screenings; and staging of art or cultural performances.
